I am pleased to announce that Secretary Gina Raimondo has approved my nomination for Captain Benjamin Evans to serve as the next Director, Office of Coast Survey in the National Ocean Service. This senior position in the NOAA Office of Marine and Aviation Operations and NOAA Commissioned Officer Corps has been submitted to the President for the appointment.
