- Ran outstanding disproval radii extending beyond the survey limits in H13388.
- Acquired mobile Lidar to position baring features in H13389 and H13390.
- Delay time due to weather.
- Acquired all bottom samples.

- Temporarily standing down Sea Scanner operations
- Mobile Lidar acquisition to position baring features in H13390
- Inshore fill in H13389 and H13390
- Potential to stand down *Broughton* operations towards the end of the week while final fill and investigation plans are prepared.
