OPR-K375-KR-20 Houston Ship Channel, TX

Recap

- Resumed survey operations running fill and investigations in H13389.
- Two weather days.

Looking Forward

- Fill and investigation in H13388, H13389, and H13390. Vessel tide float at the CO-OPS gauge at Eagle Point.
- Expecting additional weather delay.



OPR-E350-KR-20 Central Chesapeake Bay, VA - MD

Recap

- The RV Oyster Bay II continued survey on H13342 (Sheet 4).
- April 30 and May 1, 2021, were 1.5 days in port due to weather conditions.
- Survey progress on Sheet 4 was slowed by abundant marine life and refraction in the survey area degrading the quality of the sonar data and requiring re-runs of survey lines.

Looking Forward

 Subject to weather conditions, survey will continue in the week ahead on H13342 (Sheet 4), H13343 (Sheet 5), and then south to H13303 (Sheet 1) in Virginia.



OPR-H355-KR-21 Key West, FL

Recap

- The *RV Chinook* and *RV Benthos* focused on mainscheme multibeam survey in H13429 until weather moved in late in the week.
- Fill and investigation plan for H13429 is in development.
- Both vessels transitioned to working on mainscheme survey for H13430.

Looking Forward

- The RV Chinook and RV Benthos will continue survey efforts in H13430.
- The RV Substantial plans to depart Beaufort, NC and transit to Florida on May 6, 2021.
