## **OPR-H321-FH-21** Approaches to Cape Canaveral, FL

## Fieldos OPR-K380-KR-21 Port Freeport & Approaches, TX

### Recap

- Systems preparations continued in order to mobilize MV Atlantic Surveyor.
- Leidos met with the Brazos River Pilots on 28JUN2021 to discuss the task order, logistics, etc.
- The RV Oyster Bay II completed pre-survey systems verification and commenced survey on H13502 (Sheet 1) on 30JUN.
- ISO 20' vans and winches were shipped from Newport, RI on 01JUL for installation on the MV Atlantic Surveyor.

### Looking Forward

- The RV Oyster Bay II will continue survey operations in the shallow water areas of OPR-K380-KR-21.
- Preparations continue in order to mobilize and transit the MV Atlantic Surveyor at the homeport in NJ.
